

CAUTSSTSA SILENT GUITAR CABLE

INSTRUMENT PATCH CABLE WITH SILENT UNPLUG ANGLED CONNECTOR



CAUTSSTSA

The CAUTSSTSA is an instrument patch cable designed to eliminate the pops and hums that occur when one disconnects their instrument during a practice or live event. Disconnected cables cause a pop or crackle to occur through the sound system when initially disconnected, and are then susceptible to an annoying hum until reconnected. There are many planned and sudden reasons why a musician will unplug their instrument during use, which typically must be muted by the sound operator to avoid these nasty noises. This cable eliminates this problem, leaving the musician free to unplug and replug their instrument as required.

The cable accomplishes this by utilizing a special sleeve on the **red angled connector** that, once fully plugged **into the instrument**, activates the connection. As soon as the **red angled connector** begins to be pulled out, the sleeve disengages the connection, leaving the line free of sound.

This cable is available in 15 feet or 25 feet, and is manufactured using the industry leading Neutrik connectors and Digiflex cable. Special order lengths are available upon request.
